How Domestic Violence Affects Corporations

Domestic Abuse comes from all ages, races, religions and economic statuses, from the poorest city neighborhoods to the swankiest suburbs. **The American Institute of Domestic Violence reports:**

- The average health-related cost per victim for treatment is estimated at \$6,200 for each incident.
- Families of domestic violence have an average of six times the number of emergency room visits, eight times of the number of physician's visits, and six times more prescription drug use than the general population.
- Of battered workers, 94% experience problems at work because of abuse, 74% are harassed at work by their abuser, 56% are chronically tardy, 28% leave work early, and 54% miss entire days.

A survey of Fortune 100 companies by Liz Claiborne, Inc noted that 49% of corporate leaders indicated domestic violence has a detrimental effect on their company's productivity while 47% said it negatively affected employee attendance. Of the corporate leaders surveyed, one-third said domestic violence affected their balance sheets and two-thirds believe financial performance would improve by addressing domestic violence.

In the workplace itself, homicide is the leading cause of death for women at work.
